Greetings! For some of my fellow Legionnaires this salutation brought about life changes that, in some instances are changes that are still with you today - those gifts that keep on giving sort.

First, let me introduce myself. Originally from Arkansas, employment moved me away and ended up spending thirty-plus years living in upstate New York. Throughout it all, I maintained a continued presence in the Air National Guard/Air Force for thirty-plus years. Multiple deployments to European and Southwest Asia theaters allowed for a broad experience. After retiring at the rank of Chief Master Sergeant (E-9), came retirement from my civilian job of twenty-three years in local government, in 2021. Maintaining my membership in the American Legion, twenty-six years and counting, has also been one of my valued accomplishments.

Let me first be frank - the job of the PSO is to be an initial point of contact regarding veteran issues. Basic information and assistance, including referral as directed by the Department Service Officer (DSO) and to coordinate efforts to assist a veteran or dependent with an accredited Veteran Service Officer (VSO). Think of the PSO as the liaison for you with the VSO and Veteran Affairs, VA medical Centers and State VSOs.


